The story is bitter sweet, it's a tale about a true love but a hidden relationship. It's also a story about fears, regrets, and hopes. The protagonists are two of the most lovable and genuine characters from the show Pretty Little Liars, Paige and Emily. Joseph Dougherty is a real Paily shipper, that's true (and seriously, who could blame him?), but he's also an amazingly talented writer. Thank you Mr Dougherty for dedicating your time and energy to write such beautiful stories about a couple who might not be "endgame" on the show, but will always be in our hearts.(By the

Joseph Dougherty is one of the writers on PLL, he knows and loves these characters, and it shows throughout the whole series. In this installment, Paige and Emily both deal with the need to keep their love hidden from the world around them, with the isolation and secrecy this entails and the fear that it will never get better for them nor others like them. And then there's a surprise visitor with a secret or two of her own. The beautifully written story picks up threads from prior installments, furthers the mystery around the disappearance of Alison DiLaurentis, who like on the show, vanished some time during highschool under mysterious circumstances and finishes on a cliffhanger.

Yet another amazing story from JD. Nobody can write Paige and Emily like he can. It's a shame we won't get this on the show, but at least we know we have someone on our side and giving us these fantastic stories on the side because he loves our girls just as much as we do.

I love this series. Joseph really knows how to capture the essence of Emily and Paige's relationship. He also knows how to make your heart ache and flutter. So this book is a win-win.

Don't pay attention to the negative reviews. This story is escalating to a great, interesting finish (which I hope isn't soon). Out of all the novellas in the series this one holds more truth for me. Growing up in rural Iowa I've experienced those suffocating winter days that literally rip the oxygen from your lungs. The sun is too bright and the air so dry it causes nose bleeds. I love JD's grasp of these kinds of winter days. I also related to his expression of Emily and Paige's fears. Loneliness, isolation, shame. No one should ensure that pain but even in this world, in 2016, it is still there. We can marry but can't hold hands or kiss in public. The fears this story communicates are real to this day. I say, as a PLL fan, this is a great addition to JD's collection of "Paily" stories. We as fans should count ourselves lucky a writer of his substance and magnitude would put so much of his own time into these stories.

Another beautiful instalment of a series of beautiful stories, featuring two of Pretty Little Liars' most beautiful characters. Gorgeously written, Joseph manages to evoke all manner of emotions as he writes about the love the two of them share and the struggles they face, being two girls in love in

that period of history.
